1. Welcome and Introductions – (Abdi & Sky)
2. Review of Minutes from 2.18.16 (Abdi)
  - No changes.
3. Mental Health
  - Dave updates that Boynton has been given approval to hire immediately (previously approved by the fees committee but was planned for fall hire). We will hire ASAP.
  - White Paper is in progress- first meeting is scheduled for next week.
  - Sub committee- Char, Abdi, Kayla, Ryan.
4. Absence Policy and Notes
  - Boynton has proposed putting an electronic absence note on our website which would prevent students from having to come to the clinic for a note. Danita has brought this to Provost to respond. Carl will continue to follow up with Danita until we get a decision.
  - There are illnesses that we do not want people coming into the clinic for. Creating appointments for the sole purpose of obtaining a note is not a good use of medical services.
1. Update from Student Health Benefit Plan Advisory Committee meeting
  - Sue provides an update. Great engagement by students.
  - Group reviewed possible changes and cost of changes.
  - Truvada was on the list to be reviewed. (Truvada decreases the risk of contracting HIV) Group voted to approve with coverage of Truvada- it will be added to the formulary.
  - We anticipate about 38 people will use the drug which will equate to about \$325,000. Coverage will start April 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - Projection from Blue Cross is 5% decrease for next year. This will help absorb the cost of including Truvada. We anticipate no increase in SHBP cost for next year.
  - Current cost of Student Health Benefit Plan is \$999 a semester with no deductible. There is no Blue Cross plan on the market that doesn't include a deductible. People in this age range 18-25 on the market would pay more than \$300 a month for health care coverage.
5. Grocery Store Shuttle
  - There were over 70 riders for the first run of the shuttle on Sunday, February 28th.
  - Cub Foods has agreed to fund the rest of the semester (Boynton covered first date, MSA will cover the second date). Cost is about \$8000 to run.
6. SHAC Chair opening, we will vote next week.
7. Student Service Fee Committee
  - Public hearings for the Student Service Fees are scheduled and open to the public. They will be held this Friday, March 4<sup>th</sup>, Coffman Union Beacon Room from 4pm-5pm. SHAC members are invited to attend.
