



COVID Vaccination Survey 2021 Methodology


Random Sample 12,500

Degree seeking students, proportional grad and undergraduate

Employees .5 FTE appointment or greater, proportional sample of Faculty, Administrative, Professional, Civil Service and Union Represented

Response Rate: 50.6%






COVID Vaccination Survey 2021 Results

- 93% of respondents have had one or more doses of COVID vaccines
- 84.1% of survey respondents received 2 doses of Moderna or Pfizer or the one dose of Johnson & Johnson
- **45%** of those who had not been vaccinated, plan of getting vaccinated by fall.
- 96% of the population are expected to be vaccinated by fall 2021.






COVID Vaccination Survey 2021 Methodology

Should we trust the results?

- Spring College Student Health Survey indicated 88.4% of students either had been or intended to be vaccinated.
- The survey demographics match up well with overall University demographics
- Surveys have indicated that the U of M has a "vaccine friendly" population. 70% of students were vaccinated for influenza in the 2021.
- A response rate of 50.6% is very high for a survey like this. We did not identify COVID or vaccination in the subject line.






COVID Vaccination Survey 2021 Results

98.6%	96.5%	95.3%	92.4%	88.8%






COVID Vaccination Survey 2021 Results Students

95.2%	86.5%	78.2%






COVID Vaccination Survey 2021

Reasons for not getting vaccinated among those who indicated they were not getting vaccinated or unsure

72%	I am concerned about potential long term side effects of the vaccine.
58.5%	I want to wait until I have more assurance about the safety of the vaccine.
32.9%	I believe it is riskier to get vaccinated than the risks associated with getting COVID.
30.9%	I am concerned about the short term side effects of the vaccine.
18.7%	I already had COVID therefore I believe the vaccine is not necessary for me





COVID Vaccination Survey 2021

Reasons for not getting vaccinated among those who indicated they were not getting vaccinated or unsure

15%	There is no information I am aware of that will convince me to get vaccinated
13.5%	I have a medical condition or religious belief that makes me ineligible for the vaccine
12.2%	Other
1.2%	I tried to get vaccinated, but I gave up trying when I couldn't get access to the vaccine
0%	I am concerned I do not have insurance that will cover the cost of getting vaccinated


